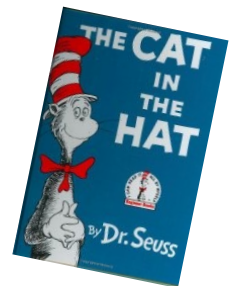
**PI DAY**
