Update on garden kaleidoscope – collaborative project between the art teacher at Eagle Elementary and the library and the Eagle Nature Trail as sponsor.

I would like to use the \$2,000 that was allocated in 2022 for a library and school project and library and Eagle Nature Trail project. This would then trigger a \$500 donation from Generac. I have solicited a \$450 donation from Andrea and Tony Bryant. And I will contribute \$500. The total would be \$3,450 of \$4,000 needed for the kaleidoscope garden art sculpture with a single viewing station. At \$3,450, I am able to let R.C. Anderson know where we are with the project and that puts the project in motion. I have costed the concrete slab at \$800 and we need \$200 for shipping costs.
