The Bridges Library System has been working for many months with the tech team at Waukesha County to develop a data dashboard for all member libraries to use. When finalized in the next couple of weeks, this will supplant the deluge of excel spreadsheets Mellanie Mercier generates for us about circulation, usage, and other important data. Instead, we will have a modern, user-friendly dashboard that updates daily and provides a variety of filters to help us sort and cross-reference data including historical data comparisons. Having high quality data available any time will make it easier to make good, data-driven decisions.
